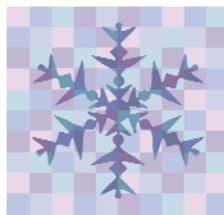

HEAP Winter Crisis Program

&

PIPP PLUS PLAN

Eligible households in emergency situations may qualify to receive up to \$175 in payment assistance for utility services. Runs from November 1, 2014 - March 31, 2015.

Under PIPP Plus, eligible customers pay six percent of their monthly income or \$10 a month, whichever is greater, to both electric and gas utilities.

You Must Bring:

- Photo ID and Social Security Card for Each Adult in Your Household
- Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, or Medical Card for Each Child
- Proof of Income
- Proof of Current Address
- Landlord statement or lease accompanied by a utility bill.
- Applicants who own a home, must have a copy of their loan application.
