WHAT: Electric bill payment assistance to eligible families

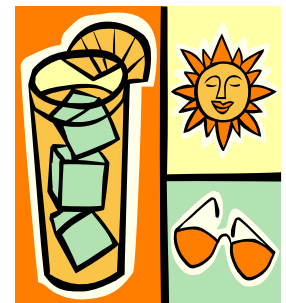
WHEN: Monday, June 4, through Friday, Aug. 31, 2012.

WHO:

- Low income families
- Households with a disconnection notice
- Households with a member whose doctor has verified that they would benefit from having an air conditioner.
- Households with a member age 60 or over may also qualify.

WHERE: Beginning Friday, June 1, customers may make an appointment to determine household eligibility by calling the automated appointment line at 1-866-504-7379. Beginning June 4, Community Action Partnership will accept a limited number of walk-in customers at the 719 S. Main St. office each weekday beginning at 8 a.m. Customers may also be seen at the Job Center, 1111 S. Edwin C. Moses Blvd.

FOOD SAFETY TIPS

Remember the

2-2-4 RULE

- Food left out of the refrigerator for more than 2 hours (1 hour if it's 90° F) may not be safe to eat—it's best to discard
- Store refrigerated leftovers in a shallow container—about 2 inches deep or less.
- Consume or freeze leftover within 4 days
