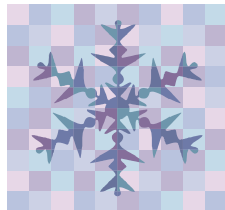

PIPP PLUS PLAN

Eligible households in emergency situations may qualify to receive up to \$175 in payment assistance for utility services.

Under PIPP Plus, eligible customers pay six percent of their monthly income or \$10 a month, whichever is greater, to both electric and gas utilities.

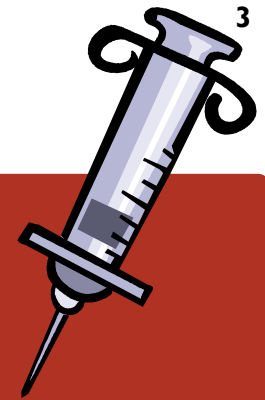

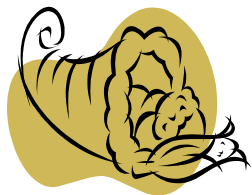
You Must Bring:

- Proof of Current Address
- Landlord statement or lease accompanied by a utility bill.
